

BID PROPOSAL

LINCOLN COUNTY RECYCLING PAVING PROJECT 2024

Lincoln County is seeking bids for asphalt paving at the Recycling Center located at 54 Huntoon Hill Road, Wiscasset. The project consists of three areas totaling approximately 20,000 square feet.

Scope of work to be performed:

A. Areas to be worked:

- 1. Entrance – 25 x 155 feet**
- 2. Exit – 43 x 120 feet**
- 3. Roll-off Dumpster Storage (currently unpaved) – 110 x 100 feet**
- 4. Align paved area to match Sallyport approach**
- 5. Aprons of Entrance and Exit will need slope correction**

B. Requirements:

- 1. Prep work if needed**
- 2. Shim as necessary**
- 3. Grind butt joints.**
- 4. Tack all areas.**
- 5. Sweeping and traffic control signs.**

A pre-bid site inspection is required for all bidders. Contact Tim Richardson or Brian McLaughlin at 882-5276 to schedule a visit. Bidders will need to verify measurements, as those provided are estimates.

Bids should be submitted in a sealed envelope marked “Recycling Paving Bid” to the Lincoln County Commissioners Office no later than 2:00 p.m. on May 2, 2024. The bids will be opened at 9am on May 7, 2024 at the County Commissioners’ meeting.

Construction with Hot Mix Asphalt shall occur only when the surface on which the material to be placed is dry, and when the atmospheric temperature is 45°F and rising. Paving on this project will be completed by August 31, 2024. All paving operations shall cease when the surface to repave becomes wet.

All mixing, spreading, finishing, compacting, and constructing joints shall be in conformance with applicable MAINEDOT Standards.

Lincoln County reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and may negotiate with an apparent successful bidder to modify the scope of the work.

Before beginning work, all bidders shall submit proof of insurance covering worker's compensation, general commercial liability, or an acceptable alternative in the amount of \$1,000,000.

Lincoln County reserves the right to add contract terms necessary to protect County operations if not specifically addressed in the bidder's contract. Before awarding the contract, any bidder may be required to show they have or can obtain in a timely manner, the necessary equipment, experience, ability and financial resources to perform the work in a manner satisfactory to the County.

All bids are required to include the following information:

- 1. Name and business address of principal owner of the firm**
- 2. Number of years in the business under the current firm name**
- 3. Type of work performed by the firm**
- 4. Type of equipment to be used on the project**
- 5. Number of personnel that will be assigned to the project and their years' of experience**
- 6. Recent municipal references (preferred) and phone numbers for whom similar work was performed (non-municipal commercial references may be provided as an alternative).**
